To Request a DPP Parking Pass

1. Fill out the application form completely, including which games you plan to attend.
2. Include a copy of your valid disabled parking placard (blue or red) issued by your state DMV. The placard must be valid on each game day. *If you have a state-issued disabled license plate, simply provide your license plate number.*
3. Include a copy of your current registration for the placard or license plate.
4. Submit your completed application and documents by one of the following methods:

1. Eligibility Requirements

To participate, applicants must have a valid **state-issued disabled parking placard** (blue or red) or a **disabled license plate**. The placard or plate must be valid on each requested game day.

2. Availability

Parking spaces will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

3. Required Application Packet

Incomplete applications cannot be processed. Please ensure your submission includes:

- A completed application form indicating the games you plan to attend
- A copy of your disabled parking placard
- A copy of the placard or license plate registration

4. Payment

Starting in mid-July, payments will be processed every 2-weeks by the Athletic Ticket Office (ATO) using the credit card on file. If no card is on file, the ATO will contact you for payment.

- Season parking passes (7 home games) are \$100
- Single-game passes are \$25/game
- Fees waived for eligible disabled military veterans

5. Duplicate Permit Policy

For those assigned a parking space through their Seminole Boosters package, please note that selecting an ADA parking location will cancel the Booster parking assignment.

6. Disabled Parking Placard/Plate Holder Attendance Requirement

The Holder of the placard is issued must be present on game day to use the assigned space. If the placard holder is not attending, alternate parking must be used. Photo ID may be requested to confirm attendance.

Digital parking passes as well as tickets (if applicable) will be uploaded to your ticket account at least two weeks prior to the first home game.

The majority of DPP parking spaces will be located on the first three floors of the West Pensacola Street Parking Garage (Booster Lot 9).

A complimentary shuttle service will be available to and from the stadium to help ensure a smooth and comfortable experience on game days.

Please note: Most parking spots in this area will not be individually reserved. Guests may park in any open space within the designated DPP zones on floors 1 through 3. However, reserved spots with access aisles will be provided for guests requiring wheelchair access or extra space for entering/exiting their vehicle.

- The facility opens five hours before kick-off, unless an earlier time is announced.
- Upon arrival, show your digital game day parking permit and state-issued placard to the garage attendant.
- Reentry is not permitted once you leave the garage.
- Tailgating is permitted but limited to your space. Grills are not allowed in the garage.
- All vehicles must be removed by 5 PM on the day following the game.
